

# 2024-25 SFFSC Fundraising Requirements & Opportunities



## Requirements

**Home Club Members:** \$175 per family

**Secondary Members:** \$75 per family

**Aspire Members:** \$50 per family

Fundraiser and Volunteer Fee Deposits are tracked and payment is processed electronically through an invoice in your SFFSC account. This gives you the ability to view your balance and see your credits applied throughout the year. In your account, you will find an invoice that contains both the Fundraiser and Volunteer Fee Deposit. This invoice is dated 6/1/25 and will stay in pending status and not be processed until this date. This invoice will only process for the full amount if the requirement is not met; and will only process partial amounts if you have earned a portion of that requirement.

*\*Members will be allowed to pay for any shortages until May 6, 2025. Fundraising invoices will be due and processed on June 1, 2025 for the full amount if no requirements are met or for the remaining balance for any partial balances remaining\*.*

## Fundraising Opportunities

### ● **Skate-A-Thon**

- Sunday, October 20, 2025 from 3:00-3:45 PM
- Get family, friends and neighbors to sponsor your athlete to achieve certain skating goals within the hour. (Example: 50 laps, 10 axles, 20 sit spins)
- Everything you earn (minus \$25 to participate) goes towards fundraising goal

### ● **Butter Braid Fundraiser**

- Sell Butter Braids to friends, families, and neighbors.

- **All Orders (online and paper forms) are due on Wednesday, March 26, 2025. Paper order forms must include a check (payable to SFFSC) for the total amount.**

- Ad Sales due November 1, 2024 (Holiday) and April 1, 2025 (Spring Show)

### ● **Annual Spring Show Message Bubbles**

# SFFSC Volunteer Requirements & Opportunities



## Requirements

**Home Club Members:** 16 Hours or \$300 buyout

**Home Club Members:** (1st yr only): 10 hours or \$150 buyout

**Secondary Members:** 5 hours or \$75 buyout

**Aspire Members:** 4 hours or \$75 buyout

Families are required to volunteer at events throughout the season. We encourage parents to sign up for volunteer opportunities that correspond with the events in which their athletes participate. There are many opportunities in which your athlete can also complete volunteer hours. It takes many hands to make light work of hosting these memorable opportunities for our athletes. Thank you for doing your part to help make this season a fun and successful one.

- **Autumn Classic Competition** - October 25-26, 2024
  - Announcer, music player, check-in table, decoration crew, awards, ice monitor, hospitality room, runners.
  - **15+ available volunteer hours**
- **Parade of Lights** - Black Friday - November 29, 2024
  - Building (usually takes place the weekend prior)
  - Walkers in the parade
  - **20+ available volunteer hours**
- **Holiday Show** - December 15, 2024
  - Announcer, music player, locker room attendant (must be safesport certified), rink side monitor, admission, decorating crew.
  - **16+ available volunteer hours**
- **Sioux Falls Challenge Cup** - March 15-16, 2025
  - Announcer, music player, check-in table, decoration crew, awards, ice monitor, hospitality room, runners.
  - **90+ available volunteer hours**
- **Annual Spring Show** - May 3, 2025 (Dress rehearsal May 2, 2025)
  - Announcer, music player, locker room attendant (must be safesport certified), rink side monitor, admission, decorating crew, raffle baskets, bake sale, flowers.
  - **1 hr** of volunteer time for families with high school sophomores or juniors will be dedicated to show teardown.
  - **25+ available volunteer hours**
- **Volunteer Coaching and Skater Council**
  - Volunteer opportunities that your skaters can do to be more involved in the club and work toward your required hours. (email [info@sffsc.com](mailto:info@sffsc.com) for more info)

**\*All volunteer opportunity sign ups will be done through Sign Up Genius specific to each event\***

*Note: If skater participates in show: 1 hrs required per show event. If a skater participates in a club competition a minimum of 3 volunteer hours must be completed at that specific event. All volunteer hours must be completed by the Spring Show on May 3, 2025. All deposit balances will be processed June 1, 2025.*
